- ▶ It is banishment from God's presence. (2 Thessalonians 1:9)
- ▶ It is a place of punishment. (2 Peter 2:9; Matthew 25:46)
- ▶ It is black and dark. (Jude 1:13; 2 Peter 2:4)
- ▶ It is fire. (Revelation 21:8; Matthew 13:42)
- There is weeping and gnashing of teeth there, indicating intense pain and suffering. (Matthew 13:42)
- \blacktriangleright There is no rest there. (Revelation 14:9-11)
- ▶ It is everlasting. There remains no longer any hope for relief. (Jude 1:13)
- ▶ It is avoided only by trusting in Jesus Christ. (John 3:16)
