

**The First and the Last  
The Alpha and the Omega  
The Beginning and the End**

<b>Revelation 1:8</b> <i>"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord [Jehovah God, NWT], "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."</i>	This verse says that the Almighty, i.e., God, is the Alpha and the Omega and the Beginning and the End.
<b>Isaiah 41:6</b> <i>Thus says the Lord, the King of Israel, And his Redeemer, the Lord of hosts: "I am the First and the Last; besides Me there is no God."</i>	This verse says that God is the First and the Last. Therefore, God is the Alpha and the Omega and the Beginning and the End and the First and the Last.
<b>Revelation 22:12-13</b> <i>"And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End and the First and the Last."</i>	We see from these verses that the one who is the Alpha and the Omega and the Beginning and the End is the one who is coming soon. The one who is coming soon can be none other than Jesus Christ Himself (Mt. 24:3, 27, 30, 44; 1 Thes. 2:19; 3:13; 5:23; 2 Thes. 2:1). But since we have already seen that God is the Alpha and the Omega then Jesus must be God.
<b>Revelation 1:17-18</b> <i>". . . Do not be afraid; I am the First and the Last. I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore, Amen."</i>	Additionally, we see from these verses that He who is the First and the Last is He who was dead and is alive forevermore. This can be none other than Jesus Christ Himself. But since we have already seen that God is the First and the Last, we must conclude that Jesus Christ is God Himself.

**The First and the Last the Alpha and the Omega the Beginning and the End**

1. The Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End = God.
2. God = the First and the Last.  
Therefore, God = the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last.
3. The Alpha and The Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last, (i.e., God), = the one who is coming soon.
4. Jesus = the one who is coming soon.  
Therefore, God = Jesus
5. The First and the Last, (i.e., God) = He who was dead and is alive forevermore.
6. He who was dead and is alive forevermore = Jesus.  
Therefore, God = Jesus.
