
The local congregation, called the "Kingdom Hall" is guided by unpaid male elders who arrange meetings, teaching times, speakers, and more.






"Selective foreknowledge means that God could choose not to foreknow indiscriminately all the future acts of his creatures. This would mean that, rather than all history from creation onward being a mere rerun of what had already been foreseen and foreordained, God could with all sincerity set before the first human pair the prospect of everlasting life in an earth free from wickedness.




Man does not have an eternal, immortal soul.

Man does not have an immortal soul that continues in conscious existence after the death of the body. The soul is not separate from the body. The soul and spirit are distinct, but the spirit is not the conscious part of man, but rather is a "life force."

"As stated, man 'came to be a living soul'; [sic] hence man was a soul, he did not have a soul as something immaterial, invisible, and intangible residing inside of him."


The Biblical Doctrine of Hell

1. It was prepared for the devil and his angels.


Matthew 25:41 "Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels."

Jude 1:13 "raging waves of the sea, foaming up their own shame; wandering stars for whom is reserved the blackness of darkness forever."


