

Jesus is God

Well, you would have to do some crazy spiritual gymnastics to become a JW... I just made this short list. Feel free to add to the list if you want.

Jesus is called Mighty God in Isa 9:6. Just like Jehovah is called Mighty God in the next chapter. "Well, that doesn't mean he is God"

Jesus said he would raise his own body from the dead in John 2. "That doesn't mean he is God"

Jesus forgave sins even though only God can forgive sins (Mark 2). "That doesn't mean he is God"

Jesus, even when he walked the earth, has all authority in heaven and earth. "That doesn't mean he is God"

Jesus is called both Son of Man and Son of God. "That doesn't mean he is God"

In Acts Jehovah is called "Sovereign Lord". In 1 Timothy 6:15 Jesus is called the "only Sovereign". "That doesn't mean he is God"

Jesus is called "I am", the name of God from the OT. The soldiers fell to the ground when he said this (John 18:6) and others wanted to stone him for blasphemy (John 8:58). "That doesn't mean he is God"

Jesus said "ask ME anything" and he would answer (John 14:14). "Well, the NWT has removed the word ME in the New World Translation, even though it is in the greek. So that doesn't mean he is God"

Jesus said only God is GOOD. Jehovah is called the Shepherd in the OT. Jesus called himself the GOOD SHEPHERD. "That doesn't mean he is God. And by the way, we don't use the word "good" shepherd in the NWT".

Thomas called Jesus "My Lord and my God". "That doesn't mean he is God".

Jesus was repeatedly worshiped in the Bible. When John wanted to worship the angel he was rebuked. Jesus did not rebuke anyone for worshiping him. "That doesn't mean he is God"

Btw; Charles Taze Russell, the founder of the Watchtower organization, also worshiped and prayed to Jesus. Today they say it is idolatry to worship Jesus. Was Russell committing idolatry?

Jesus is called "Lord of Lords" just as Jehovah in the OT. "Well, that doesn't mean he is God"

John 1:3 states that Jesus created all things and nothing was created without Jesus. Jesus could not be a created being since nothing was made without Jesus. "Well, that doesn't mean he is God"

In Isa 45, talking about Jehovah, it says: "To me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear allegiance." In Phil 2:10 the exact same words is attributed to Jesus:

At the name of Jesus, "every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord." "Well, that doesn't mean he is God"

In the OT it says that Jehovah is coming. But when we read the NT it says Jesus is the one that is coming. "Well, that doesn't mean he is God"

The OT says Jehovah is the one that will judge the world. If you were a pre-Christian Jew living before Jesus came you would believe Jehovah would be the judge. Because that was being told in the OT. When Jesus came he said he himself would be the Judge (John 5). "Well, that doesn't mean he is God"

1 John 5:20 states that Jesus is "the true God and eternal life."

"Well, that doesn't mean he is God"

Watchtower says that "call upon" means prayer and should be directed ONLY to God. The first Christians was said to "call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ" (1. Corinthians 1:2).
