I noticed in the article that the term unreasonable and the term reasonable were each used once. This is typical of my reading experience. The key to understanding Scripture from a JW perspective seems to be its "reasonableness". That reminds me of the following quote:

The Watchtower leadership are theological rationalists. Theological rationalism is defined as "the practice of treating reason as the ultimate authority in religion." When they come across something about God, human existence, the resurrection, the omnipotence or Omnipresence of God, they build a supposed rational explanation as to why the Bible doesn't actually say – or at least does not mean – what it clearly says and means.
