

The purpose of a miracle or sign is to authenticate the message and/or the messenger. The miracles of Jesus authenticated his proclamations and his identity. The miracles of the apostles authenticated their message and their ministry. The Bible warns us of false prophets and apostles. Claims expanding the teaching of the Old and New Testament would certainly have to be verified by God. Based on Biblical precedent, the idea that God will do a new thing in a way that is non-falsifiable is itself false. For example, the Jehovah's Witnesses claim that Jesus began ruling as an invisible being in 1914. How do I prove an invisible Jesus is not there? Am I to accept their claim because I cannot prove it wrong? No, the burden of proof is on them. Non-falsifiable statements are not adequate. In the same way, how do I know people are apostles if they deny that there is any way to verify their apostleship. Their self-identification is not sufficient. Why would we think God has stopped verifying his message and messengers?
